Alcohol Awareness Roadshow: An invitation to attend a Professionals' Awareness Roadshow on Tuesday 13 November 2018, Alcoholics Anonymous is holding a Roadshow at Tricky's Hotel, Tolgus Mount, Redruth, TR15 3TA. This event is intended to inform the public and professionals about how Alcoholics Anonymous works. Although AA is an anonymous fellowship, it is not secret or invisible. Our aim is to show how men and women in the grip of alcohol dependency are able to recover. According to Public Health Surveys as many as one in four adults in Cornwall drink alcohol at "hazardous levels". Research shows that every ten years there is a notable increase in the number of young people affected by liver disease as a direct result of alcohol consumption.
