**From father Michael** – If you were only to go to Mass once a year, the Mass you should come to is the Easter Vigil. Everything in our Catholic life flows from this one Liturgy. In the darkness of this night a candle is lit. In the darkness of this night Jesus rises from the dead. In the darkness of this night new Christians are baptised and confirmed. We renew our faith. We listen to Holy Scripture and celebrate together the first Eucharist of Easter.

## **A meditation for the fifth Sunday of Lent - The Raising of Lazarus – by Pope Francis**

The message is clear: Jesus gives life even when it seems that all hope has gone. There are moments when life seems to be a sealed tomb: everything is dark, and we can see only sorrow and despair around us. Today's miracle tells us that it is not like that, that is not the end, that in these moments we are not alone. On the contrary, it is precisely in these moments that he comes closer than ever to restore life to us. Jesus weeps: the Gospel tells us that Jesus wept in front of Lazarus' tomb, and today Jesus weeps with us, as he was able to weep for Lazarus. And at the same time Jesus invites us not to stop believing and hoping, not to let ourselves be crushed by the negative feelings that take away our tears. He approaches our tombs and says to us, as then: Take away the stone: the pain, the mistakes, even the failures. Do not hide them inside you, in a dark, lonely, closed room. And Jesus says, "Come out!" So this is the moment to take away the stone and to go out towards Jesus, who is close. Can we open our hearts to him and entrust our worries to him?
