**From Father Michael** – Many people these days are deeply anxious about the cost of living, the state of the nation, the state of the world, so anxious that it is affecting their mental health. Where is all this conflict and violence going to end? I came across these words by Iain McGilchrist, a former consultant psychiatrist at the Bethlem and Maudsley Hospital in London: “We need a renewal of worship, of ritual . . . We cannot survive without a return to that form of poetry, evoked through liturgy, through sacred art and music, and of course, exemplified for us in the lives of the saints, all of which constitute a living repository of spiritual nourishment.” What better description could there be of our parish festival of music and art?
